

CleanSports Service is Simple and Convenient

CleanSports has streamlined the equipment cleaning process to provide the most convenient options for using our services. Customers may choose to visit the CleanSports Operation Center directly for service, or drop off their gear at one of our Drop Zone establishments. Whichever option is selected, all customer equipment is cleaned at the CleanSports Operation Center for the same price.

Check In: Bring your equipment to the CleanSports Operation Center or Drop Zone establishment near you. Your equipment items will be inspected and documented, and a receipt is printed for pickup. Your equipment is placed into a numbered, red plastic bag ready for loading into the wash system.

Loading: Your equipment is loaded into a patented, protective mesh bag that safely secures your gear during the cleaning and sanitizing process. Special attention is given to the positioning of your equipment in the bag to ensure the best cleaning results. Presoaking of heavily soiled items like gloves is often performed.



Cleaning: Your equipment goes through a series of wash, rinse, and extract cycles before the final drying process. CleanSports uses advanced detergents, disinfectants and a finishing fragrance to ensure that your equipment is professionally cleaned to your satisfaction. This includes our Force disinfectant that effectively eliminates bacteria and fungus from the equipment.

Drying: Your equipment comes out smelling fresh and clean but still retains approximately 10% moisture content at this stage to keep leathers soft and prevent overheating of plastics used in the gear. A final stage on the finishing rack and the equipment is completely dry.



Check Out: Your cleaned and sanitized equipment is placed in a clear, plastic bag and is ready for your pickup at either the CleanSports Operation Center or your selected Drop Zone establishment.



The Cleaning Process Designed for the Tough Stuff

CleanSports uses a four step cleaning process specifically designed for the filthiest of sports gear. This wet wash, EPA-registered process uses low temperature, low agitation cycles to thoroughly clean, sanitize and deodorize sports gear without the damaging effects found in standard washing methods.



Stage 1:

TAK1 Detergent.

This enzyme based detergent breaks down organic compounds present in odor causing contaminants inside the equipment. This first wash of the equipment helps to eliminate some of the awful smell associated with dirty sports equipment.

Stage 2:

Penetrator Detergent.

This powerful detergent is designed to work deep into the foam and fabrics of the protective gear breaking down stains and foreign bodies like mucus, blood, sweat, dander, fungus, bacteria and mold that is common place in equipment. The low temperature and neutral PH of the detergent is specifically formulated to work with the Esporta ES3250 machine.



Stage 3:

Force Additive.

This disinfectant works on potentially harmful agents in the equipment like bacteria, mold and fungus. The purpose of stage 3 is to eliminate all of these contaminants in order to prevent players from being exposed to agents that can be harmful to their health. Bacterial rash and fungal infections are just a few of the more common problems that occur from wearing unclean protective gear.

Stage 4:

Signature Additive.

This final fragrance is added to the last rinse of the process to compliment the cleaned equipment with a clean, fresh scent. This signifies that the equipment has completed our sophisticated cleaning process and is ready for delivery to the customer.

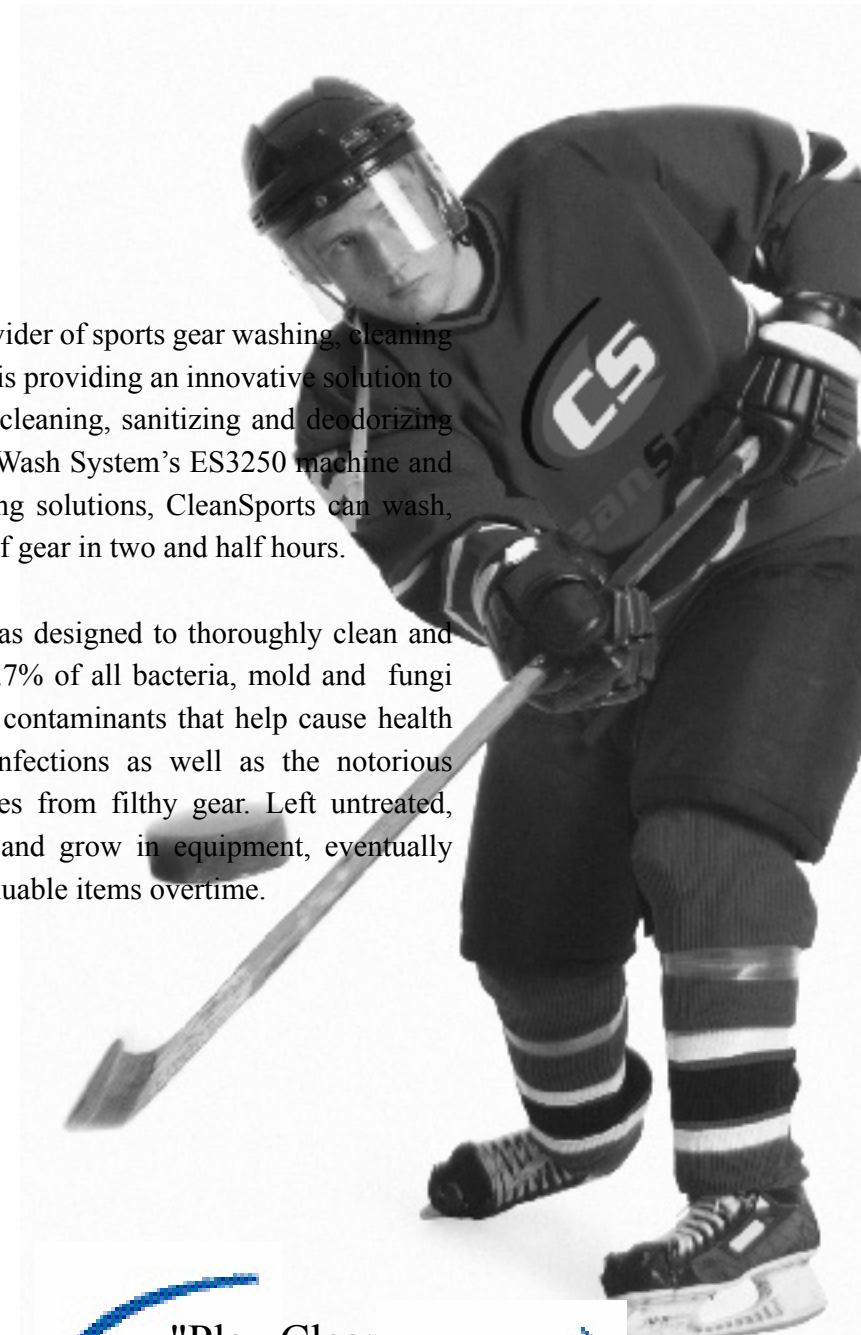
